1. Competitions will be held in Krishna Public School, Raipur (C.G.), Judo area as per the schedule which will be prepared by the CBSE observer, one week before.
2. Shared accommodation shall be provided in Hostel rooms / Classrooms at Krishna Public School, Raipur (C.G.).
3. Shared accommodation shall be provided only for Players, only one Coach and one Team Manager.
4. Parents are not allowed to stay in school.
5. Schools should bring their flag and plaque card for march past and opening ceremony.

GENERAL RULES FOR THE CONDUCTION OF JUDO CHAMPIONSHIP 2022
("GIRLS & BOYS")

- 1) The competition will be conducted as per the rules and regulations of the Judo Federation of India, unless modified in these rules.
- 2) At Zone level, only one player from each school can participate in each age group and weight category.
- 3) The participants shall be 10 years and above to participate in the competition.
- 4) Judo dress shall be as per the Technical Rules of Judo Federation of India.
- 5) The competition shall be conducted in the following age and weight categories:

- 6) The Judoka/Judosist shall be allowed to participate only in their respective weight categories (actual body weight) and no jumping in the weight categories will be allowed.
- 7) The fixtures will be drawn after having weight done of Judokas.
- 8) The competition shall be conducted on knock out-cum-single recharge system. The competition of each weight category will be separated into two groups by a draw. From each group (pool) one finalist will be established by knock out system. Each competitor, who has been defeated in his /her elimination, will be put in the recharge round which takes place in the knock out system. The winners of the two recharge groups will be awarded the joint third place (Bronze Medal).

- 9) Merit Certificate will be provided to first, second & third positions winners. (Both the semi-finalist will be provided the certificate of Merit and Bronze Medal for the third place).
- 10) All other participant's will be provided with the participation certificates.
- 11) No protest will be entertained against the judgment of officials.
- 12) The Jury of Appeal shall include:
 1. Principal Organizing School
 2. Organizing Secretary
 3. CBSE Observer
 4. Mat Chairman-Boys
 5. Mat Chairman-Girls
- 13) The school Organizing Zone level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.

NOTE:

- (1) Age & category wise entry, separately for Boys' & Girls' shall be sent to the Organizing Schools so as to reach them at least seven days before the meet.
 - (2) The Mat Chairman will be appointed by the CBSE Observer at the venue, who shall be JFI-NDIO or a NSNIS Diploma holder in Judo.
 - (3) From each Zone, in each weight category, separately in Boys & Girls, in different age groups, first & second position winners will qualify to participate in Nationals.
 - (4) All teams must report at least a day before the commencement of the championship.
 - 14) The team players reporting on **1st December 2022** will only be allowed to participate in the Championship. **Please send your team (s) accordingly.**
 - 15) The Host School will not be responsible for any miss happening during the Championship or during journey.
 - 16) All the Judoka / Judosist will bring their personal kit as JUDO items are not locally available.
 - 17) All the participating teams will be provided lodging facilities. (Adequate and safe hostel and classrooms with clean bath and toilet)
 - 18) Mattress and sheets will be provided for the teams staying.
 - 19) All the participating teams will be provided free transport facility at the time of arrival, and departure between Railway station / Bus stand / Airport .
 - 20) The teams making their own stay arrangement will not be provided with mess and transport facility.
 - 21) Accommodation will not be provided to the parents accompanying the participants.
 - 22) The boarding charges shall be *Rs. 350/- per head per day including bedding charges.** It is advised that from the health and safety point of view, all participating teams dine in the mess arranged by the Organizing school.
- (* Subject to change as per CBSE organizing rule.)

- 23) The participating schools will deposit **payments against meals on full day basis** and no part payment will be accepted and the **participating schools will not insist for refund of part payment.**

PARTICIPATING SCHOOL

Every affiliated school shall be entitled to enter its athlete/team in the CBSE Sports and Games Competitions. As soon as Calendar is uploaded on the Board's website, the schools may fill-in the online discipline-wise Entry Proformae. **No school will be permitted to participate unless they fill the online discipline-wise Entry Proformae and by-hand Entry Proformae would not be accepted.**

No team will be permitted to play unless accompanied by a teacher/coach at the venue.

In no circumstances the composition of team shall change from Cluster/Zone to National. In extra ordinary circumstances the changes may be permitted, but only with prior permission from the CBSE, in writing.

All expenses on items like travel, food, kit etc will have to be borne by the participating School.

Dining in the mess arranged by the host school is mandatory for the teams that opt to stay in the school provided accommodation.

Every player/athlete/team shall carry with them the required documents as mentioned under title "Eligibility".

Every team will carry their school flag, for the purpose of March past and to be used during the various ceremonies. Participation in March past is compulsory, failing which their right to participate can be forfeited.

It is not obligatory on the part of Organizing School to provide food & transport facility to school/teams making their own stay arrangements. Also, it is the responsibility of the school/teams staying outside, to collect information in regard to matches/fixtures/program etc.

Any non-designated person accompanying the team will not be entertained for any matter at the venue and will not be permitted to stay in the premises.

In case the player/team is being accompanied only by the parent, it should be informed by the Principal of participating school in writing.

ACCREDITED REPRESENTATIVES (TEACHER/ COACH/ MANAGER)

All the teams shall be accompanied by a Teacher/Coach/Manager designated by the participating school Principal.

No team will be permitted to participate without accompanying official.

No team shall be accompanied by any parent. However if a parent is accompanying the team, such information may be provided by the school on the school letterhead.

No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.

In case of Girls participants, one of the accompanying officials must be a female.

The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid Identity Card issued by their school Principal.

No extra person shall be permitted to stay inside the school premises and on the play field along with the teams.

COLOURS

All the participating teams shall compete in the Inter-School tournament in their respective playing uniform with the prescribed color of their school and numbered.

In case of clash of playing jersey color, it shall be decided by the spin of coin as to which team will have to change playing uniform.

ENTRIES

As soon as the Sports Calendar has been uploaded, it becomes the responsibility of the schools to fill in the entry proforma online.

Each school shall be entitled to enter only one team or individual for each tournament/meet/event.

A junior player can be permitted to play in senior age group, and then the participation in the original group will be forfeited.

Soon after filling-in the entry proforma, schools shall make travel bookings and send the information to the Organizing school for making the necessary arrangements.

Whatsoever the reason may be, on the spot entry and late entry will not be entertained.

WITHDRAWING SCHOOL

If a school, after filling-in its entry, wishes to withdraw from a tournament/meet, it shall give a written request of its intention to do so to the Organizing Secretary/School.

School withdrawing without informing/requesting the Organizing school, will be penalized with a penalty of Rs.1000/-.

IMPORTANT: IT SHALL BE MANDATORY FOR ALL THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING ON ARRIVAL AT VENUE-

- (i) The documents for verification in original if asked for.
- (ii) The team photo with school Principal along with the entry Performa, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
- (iii) To provide CBSE registration number for student/player studying in class IX and above.
- (iv) To supply the eligibility performa filled-in online, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
- (v) The Eligibility/Entry Performa in disciplines like, Judo & Swimming shall include the event/weight category in which the athlete wishes to participate.

ELIGIBILITY

Age:

The athlete/player should be within the particular age group on 31 December of the year of competition.

- (a) Only bonafide students shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-School tournaments/meets. Feeding any non bonafide student shall lead to disqualification of the team.
- (b) A student, who has failed twice in a particular class, shall no more be eligible to participate.
- (c) Incomplete information in any respect is liable for disqualification of team.
- (d) Any violation in eligibility (over age or Impersonation) shall be dealt according to rules.
- (e) The original eligibility Performa of the Athletes/Players/Teams qualifying to participate from Cluster/Zone level to National level will have to be certified by the Organizing school at the Cluster/Zone level as the case may be and forwarded to the National Organizing School, **immediately** after their Cluster/Zone level competition is over.
- (f) Medical checkup may also be applied by the Jury of Appeal appointed by the Organizing school in the cases of overage suspicion.
- (g) A player shall be under 11; 14; 17 & 19 years of age on 31 Dec 2022.
 - 1. Under 11 years: Born on or after 01.01.2012
 - 2. Under 14 years: Born on or after 01.01.2009
 - 3. Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2006
 - 4. Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2004
- (h) All the supporting papers verifying the age of the player, etc in original, as per the CBSE Guidelines & Rules shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/Coach while reporting for participation.
- (i) The player's right to participate forfeits if fails to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original on demand.

Any team/athlete not fulfilling the eligibility criteria before the commencement of the tournament/meet shall not be permitted to participate.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

A player/team may be disqualified/scratched for the following reasons.

- 1. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
- 2. Inclusion of non bonafide student in the team.
- 3. Misbehavior on ground by athlete or accompanying official.
- 4. Use of abusive language by athlete or accompanying official.
- 5. Misbehavior with Officials/Opponents by athlete or accompanying official.

6. Indiscipline at the place of stay by athlete or accompanying official.
7. Damaging the school property.
8. Indiscipline during the Opening and Closing ceremonies by athlete or accompanying official.
9. Non participation in March Past.

The Organizing School in no case shall show the eligibility performa or any other paper of a team to anyone who lodges the protest. It is only jury of appeal's prerogative to verify all the documents.

The Organizing school shall submit details of the defaulters to the Jt. Director (Sports) reporting the names of the schools/athletes, in a separate cover. All such defaulters will be debarred from the participation in CBSE Inter School Sports and Games Competition for the next year. If any of such school resorts to unfair means again, in the subsequent years, it will be debarred for three years.

PROTEST

Protest of any nature in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer within one hour of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied by a fee of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand).

Such a protest will be considered by Jury of Appeal, consisting of following:-

1. Principal, Organizing School
2. Organizing Secretary
3. CBSE Observer
4. One or two technically qualified People present at the venue

The parties under dispute may be heard before deciding the issue. In case the protest is uphold, the protest fee shall be refunded to the protesting school otherwise the fee shall be forfeited.

The decision taken by the Jury of Appeal will be final and binding.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- (i) Team Manager/Coaches shall provide the required documents for verification in original, if asked for by the controller.
- (ii) Team photo with school principal along with the entry Performa duly countersigned by the concerned principal shall be produced at the time of entry in the School Campus.
- (iii) For Students studying in class IX and above shall provide CBSE Registration Number given.

- (iv) Identity Cards to be brought by the students and coaches duly stamped and signed by the Principal.
- (v) Proof of the payment of CBSE Annual Sports fee for the year **2022-23**
- (vi) **Girl participants should be escorted by Female Escorts (Manager).**
- (vii) Participant list from school and Participant I-Card downloaded from CBSE games website dully signed by Principal.
- (viii) All **Annexure** format, registration form and travel itinerary properly filled and dully signed by Principal.

Boarding and Lodging

- ❖ Boarding & Lodging Charges will be *Rs 350/- (Rs. Three Hundred & Fifty only) per day, per head (* Subject to change as per CBSE Organizing Rule).
- ❖ Boarding & Lodging Charges will be paid in advance which are refundable depending upon facilities used.
- ❖ Security Deposit of Rs 3000/- (Rs. Three Thousand only) will also be made by each team at the time of entry which is refundable.
- ❖ All the Team Managers and player will be accommodated in the school planned separately for Boys and Girls. No accommodation for parents or any other person accompanying.
- ❖ No costly items or jewelry etc. are to be brought to the campus during championship as the school will not be responsible for the loss of any personal belongings.



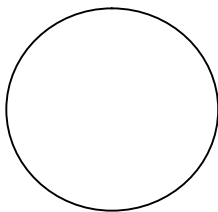
