- Maintain Records: Keep detailed records of all complaints, investigations, and actions taken, ensuring they are securely stored and handled according to legal guidelines.

4. Support and Counseling

- Provide Emotional Support: Offer counseling and emotional support to the victim and their family to help them cope with the emotional and psychological effects of the incident.
- o Collaborate with External Agencies: Work with external professionals, such as counselors, social workers, or legal experts, to ensure comprehensive support for the child.

5. Liaison with Authorities

- Coordinate with Law Enforcement: If the situation involves criminal activity, the committee is responsible for informing law enforcement agencies as per the legal requirements of the POCSO Act.
- o Collaborate with Child Welfare Committees: Cooperate with child welfare authorities to ensure the victim's protection and that the case is followed up appropriately.

6. Monitoring and Compliance

- Ensure POCSO Compliance: The committee ensures that the school is compliant with the provisions of the POCSO Act, including the creation of a child-friendly environment and child protection policies.
- o **Regular Review of Policies**: Regularly review and update the school's policies and practices related to child protection to align with the latest legal requirements and best practices.

7. Prevention Programs

- o **Implement Preventive Measures**: The committee is responsible for developing and implementing preventive measures to protect children from sexual offenses. This includes supervision, proper staff training, and security measures within the school.
- o **Promote Safe Practices**: Develop guidelines and conduct programs for both students and staff on personal safety, including the appropriate use of technology and online safety.

- Recommend Disciplinary Actions: Based on the outcome of investigations, the committee may recommend disciplinary actions against any staff member, student, or other individuals involved in misconduct.
